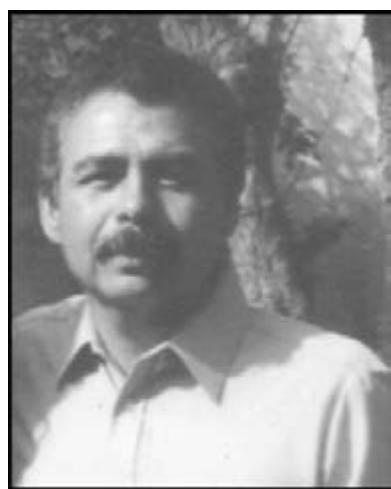

The Willacy County Navigation District (the District) is accepting sealed bid proposals to construct the Subdivision of Lot 14, Block 25 and the 2009 Overlay Project.

**SEALED PROPOSALS** addressed to Mr. Terry White, Secretary, at the **District Office, 400 W. Willacy, Suite 200, Raymondville, Texas, 78580**, will be received until **Wednesday, July 15, 2009 at 11:00 A.M.** for furnishing all materials, equipment and labor necessary for construction of the Subdivision of Lot 14, Block 25 and the 2009 Overlay Project in accordance with the plans on file at the District Office. At the time stated, bids will be publicly opened and read at the District Office.

**PLANS, SPECIFICATIONS AND CONTRACT DOCUMENTS** may be examined without charge at the District Office or the Office of Ferris & Flinn, LLC. Proposal forms may be obtained by calling Ferris & Flinn, LLC, (956) 364-2236. Complete plans, specifications and contract documents are available from Ferris & Flinn, LLC for the nonrefundable reproduction cost of \$40.00.

**A CERTIFIED OR CASHIER'S CHECK**, or an acceptable bid bond in an amount not less than five (5) percent of the total bid shall accompany each bid as a guaranty that, if awarded the Contract, the bidder will promptly enter into a contract with the District and furnish bonds on the forms provided.

**BIDDERS** are expected to inspect the site of the work and to inform themselves of all local conditions. All work shall be completed within ninety (90) calendar days after receipt of the Notice to Proceed.

The Willacy County Navigation District reserves the right to reject any or all bids, waive any or all informalities, and to award the contract to the bidder or bidders, who, in the opinion of the District offers the proposal in his best interest. The prices submitted will be unit prices and the award will be based on the estimated quantity of work outlined in the bid form. **The work includes construction of a new 4 lot subdivision including approximately 1,200 feet of waterline, 1,100 feet of sanitary sewer line, water and sewer services, culverts, and 2,600 square yards of asphalt roadway and related work. The project also includes approximately 18,000 square yards of asphalt overlay of existing streets and related preparatory work.**
